

Need An Extra Bath?

Here's a smart home improvement that saves time and money.

Thanks to macerating technology, savvy homeowners are inexpensively adding spare bathrooms anywhere they choose—even below the sewage line in their homes.

A macerating system can be installed atop any finished floor in the home. As a result, a new bathroom can be added wherever it is most convenient for you: in a basement, attic, spare bedroom, even the garage or pool house.

Tight on space? Not a problem! With a macerating toilet system, a beautiful new bathroom can even be installed under a stairway or in a closet.

Everyone knows that adding a conventional bathroom in an older home can be difficult and costly. This is especially true if the fixtures must be positioned below the septic system or in places where no below-floor drainage currently exists, requiring plumbers to bust through the concrete floor.

The little-known secret of macerating technology is that it provides a relatively simple and cost-effective alternative.

How does it work?

A macerating toilet system looks very much like a conventional water closet and takes up roughly the same amount of floor space. But instead of routing the flush water through a drain in the floor, the system moves it to a macerator pump. This pump is usually located on the floor between the toilet and the wall, or it can be hidden behind the wall.

The macerator uses a fast-rotating cutting or grinding blade to liquefy waste and toilet paper in the flush water. Within seconds, the flush water and

its contents are released under pressure through small-diameter piping to the sewer or septic tank.

Best of all, this macerating technology requires no special maintenance. The macerator motor has no gears or brushes to wear out. The motor is filled with oil and sealed for life.

Whole bath in half a day!

Only one manufacturer makes a macerating toilet system: SFA Saniflo Inc., the company that developed this "above-floor plumbing" technology nearly a half-century ago.

With a Saniflo toilet system, there's no costly excavation of the floor to install a drain line. You won't have to tear down walls and floors, and installation is quick and economical, with minimal disturbance to room layout. A complete bathroom can be operational in as little as half a day.

Properly sized, the system can handle all the fixtures in a bathroom, including the sink, shower, tub and toilet—even on a septic system. What's more, these fixtures will work up to 12 feet below and as far away as 150 feet from a septic tank or sewer line.

Where can I find one?

Saniflo macerating systems are available at hardware stores for do-it-yourselfers. They can also be purchased through plumbing wholesalers and contractors. All models in the line are low-consumption water closets. If you're ready for the convenience of an extra bathroom, you're ready for a Saniflo macerating system.
