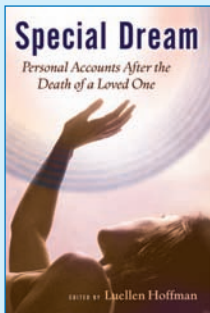


# Special Dream...Personal Accounts After the Death of a Loved One
