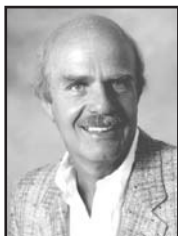
How We All Fit Together

A Warm Story About A Cold Evening

Let me end this series with one final story. It happened to me in February 1959, when I was nineteen years of age. On a particularly cold evening, I was hitchhiking home to Michigan from Patuxent River Naval Air Station in Lexington Park, Maryland. My oldest brother would be visiting too, and I would be seeing him for the first time in two years. I had reached an isolated rest stop somewhere in the middle of the Pennsylvania Turnpike. The temperature hovered around minus twenty-five degrees, and the wind was blowing so hard that I could stand hitching at the edge of the entrance ramp for only ten minutes or so at a time. It was about 3:00 in the morning, and I was walking out to another stint of hitching when I passed another sailor returning to warm himself in the gas station. It was too dark to see anything but the outline of his uniform, but since we were both in uniform we briefly exchanged words. "Be careful out there, buddy," the freezing sailor said to me. "It's so cold

that you can only stay out there a few minutes." "Thanks," I said, "I appreciate it." That was it. I went out to see if I could snare a ride, and the sailor returned to the comfort of the rest area. After fifteen minutes of standing, there was no "luck." I had to return to the rest area. As I walked into the warm room, I saw the sailor with whom I had just talked in the dark. It was my oldest brother, Jim, who was hitching home from Norfolk, Virginia, to be with his family and to see me. How many variables had to be precise to bring us together in the middle of nowhere, talking to each other in the dark, stranded in a freezing windstorm? I don't pretend to know the answer, but I do know that there are no accidents in a perfectly synchronized universe. You will see it only when you believe it.
